Classes are held in the 12-computer Lab One. Lab Two is open to members 6:15 am—9:45 pm daily.

Cal-Am provides the computers. The Computer Club provides the people to teach and monitor the room and the funds for extra hardware, software, ink and paper. Your membership is well worth the dues and includes as many meetings, classes and SIGs as you wish to attend.
